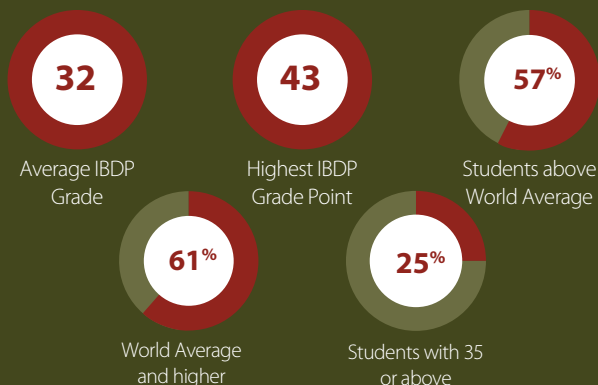
This year, we introduced three credit-bearing **electives** to our students, empowering them to explore passions and develop unique skill sets, aligning with our commitment to creating responsible global citizens. **Electives offered are:** Traditions of Indian Origin, Outdoor Living Skills, Sacred Spaces & Interfaith Dialogue.

Woodstock offers three strong diploma programs. As an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, Woodstock offers both the IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) and Diploma Programme (DP). We also offer a standalone Woodstock Diploma (U.S. High School Diploma) along with a Woodstock Diploma and Advanced Placement (APs) pathway. Students complete the IB MYP in Grade 10, while ABRSM music exams are optional.

The Class of 2025 will participate in four years of outdoor education through the week long Activity Week. Woodstock nurtures a culture of research integrity and reports serious academic or conduct issues.
